The Northeast Texas Regional Advisory Council (NETRAC) (Trauma Service Area – F) is a non-profit organization of health care entities located in the northeastern region of the State of Texas. These health care entities include hospitals, EMS providers, nurses, physicians, and other agencies interested in aiding in Trauma Care. NETRAC was formed in 1989 and chartered in 1994 by the Texas Department of State Health Services to implement and maintain a Trauma System Plan to include regional emergency medical services.
